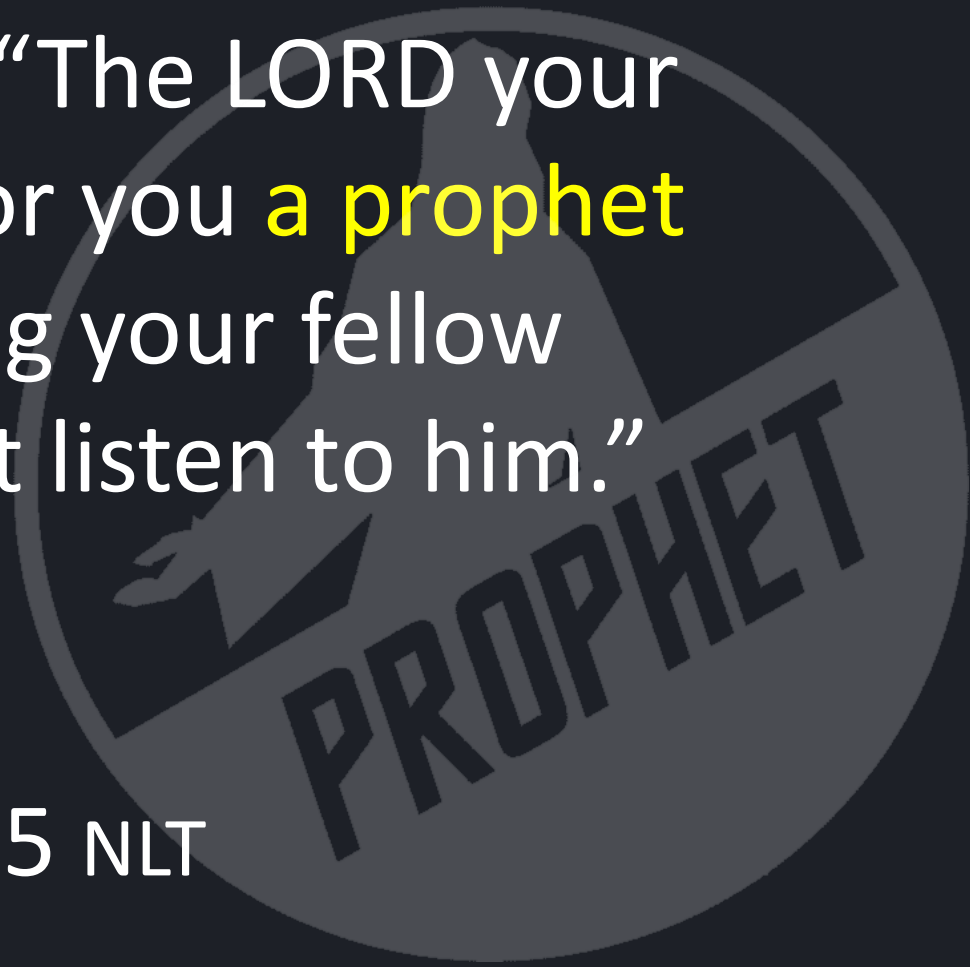

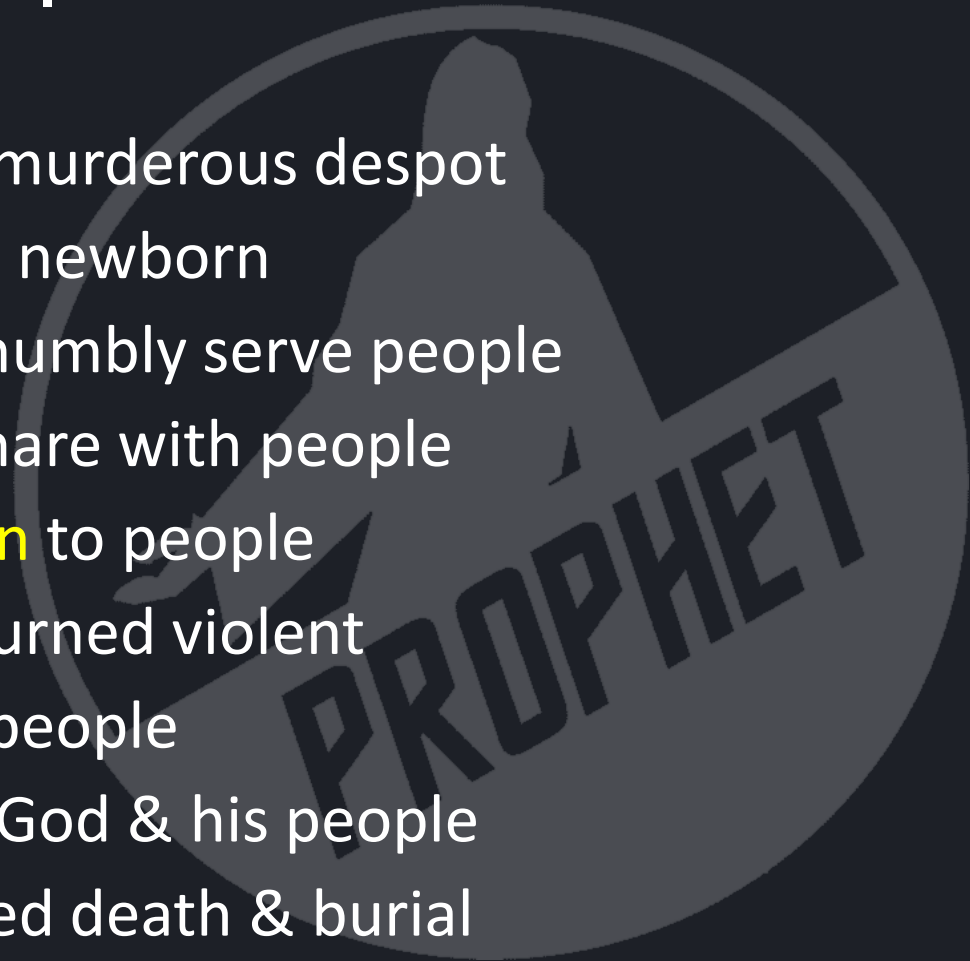

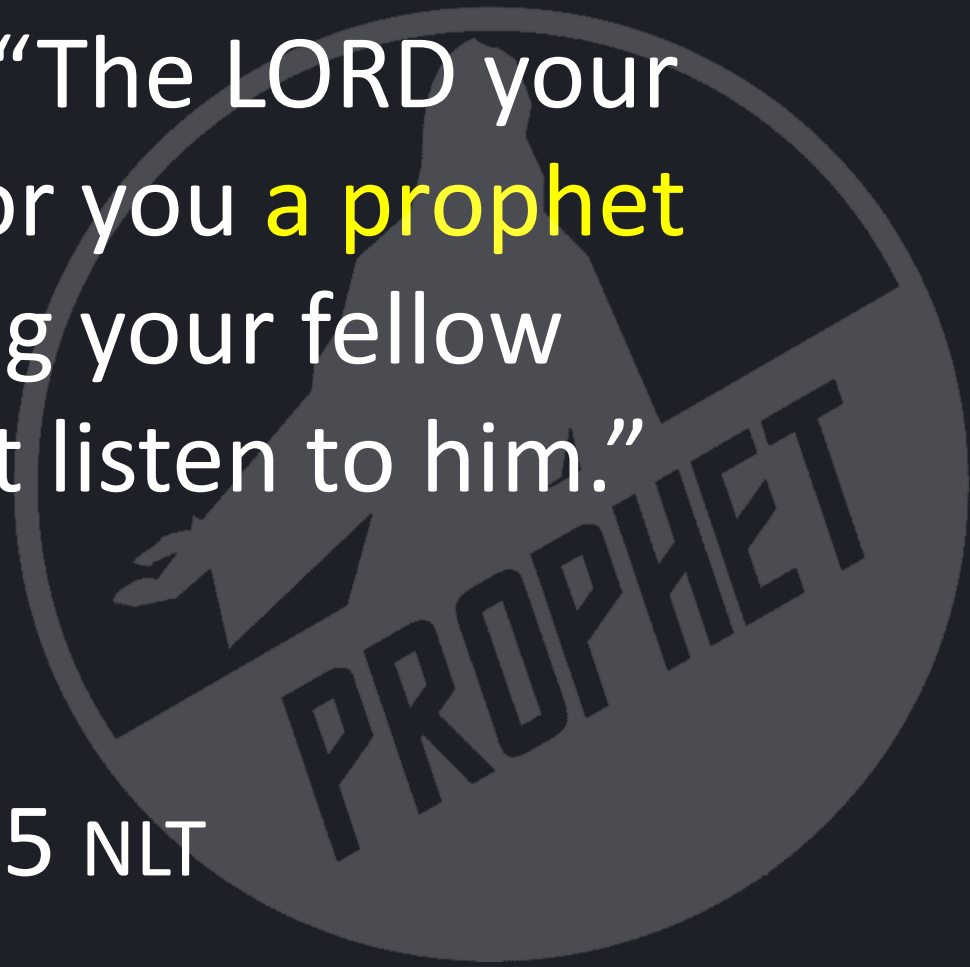
Moses | Jesus

- **Spared death** as a baby from a murderous despot
- Divinely **protected in Egypt** as a newborn
- Renounced a **royal position** to humbly serve people
- Received **divine revelation** to share with people
- Showed **remarkable compassion** to people
- Had **passion** that occasionally turned violent
- **Prayed** to God on behalf of his people
- **Mediated** a covenant between God & his people
- **Divine circumstances** surrounded death & burial

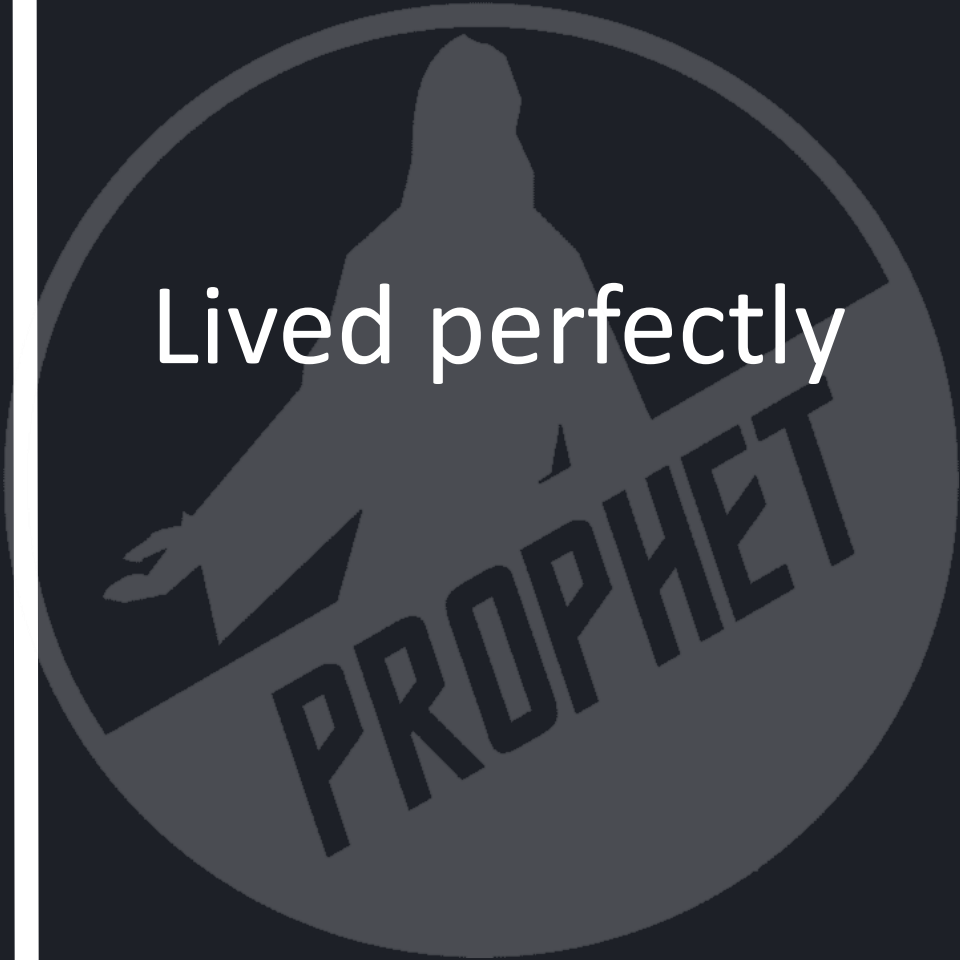

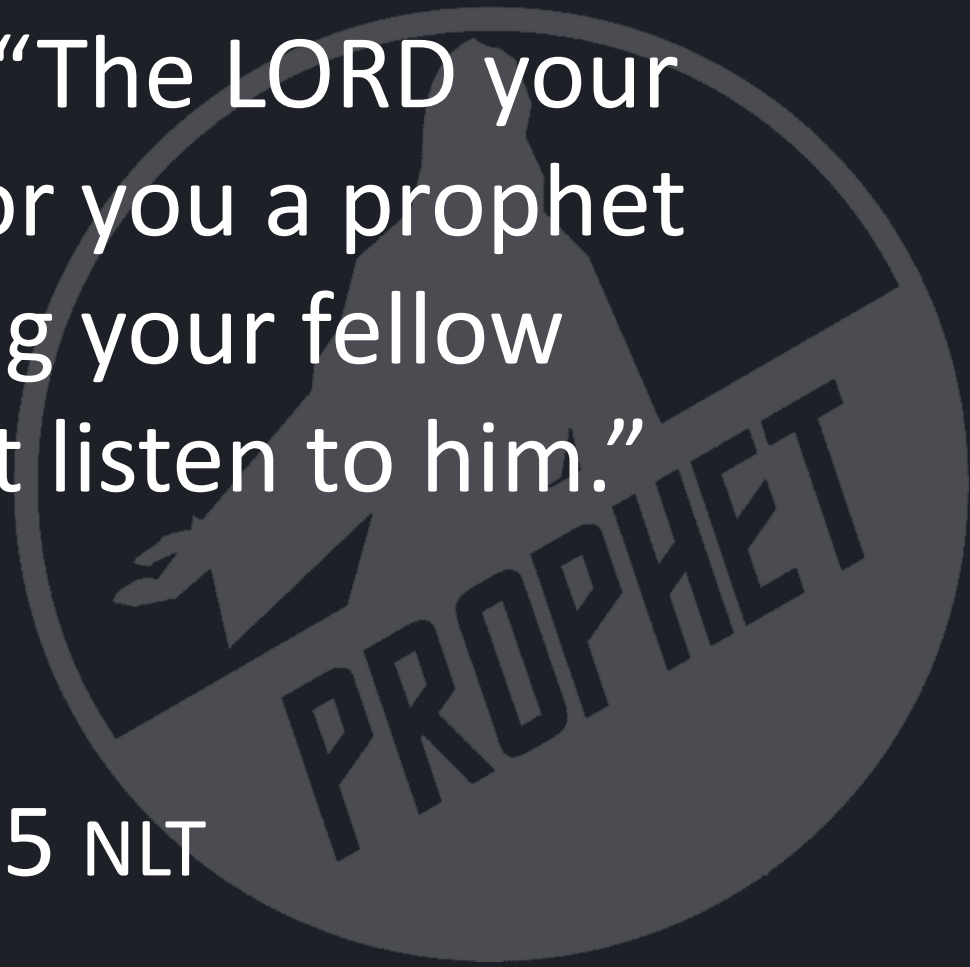
