Daniel 9:1-27 In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of Median descent, who was made king over the kingdom of the Chaldeans-- 538 B.C. ² in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, observed in the books the number of the years which was revealed as the word of the LORD to Jeremiah the prophet for the completion of the desolations of Jerusalem, namely, seventy years.



Jeremiah 25:9-11

"I will summon all the peoples of the north and my servant Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon," declares the Lord, "and I will bring them against this land and its inhabitants and against all the surrounding nations... and these nations will serve the king of Babylon seventy years."



-538 B.C. Daniel captured -538 B.C. this passage 67 years + 1 or 2

Therefore, coming up on 70 years



³ So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes. ⁴ And I prayed to the LORD my God and confessed and said, "Alas, O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments,



- ⁵ we have sinned, committed iniquity, acted wickedly, and rebelled, even turning aside from Thy commandments and ordinances.
- ⁶ "Moreover, we have not listened to Thy servants the prophets . . .



¹¹"Indeed all Israel has transgressed Your law and turned aside, not obeying Your voice; so <u>the curse</u> has been poured out on us, along with the oath which is written <u>in the law of Moses</u> the servant of God, for we have sinned against Him.



Leviticus 26:27 If in spite of this you still do not listen to me but continue to be hostile toward me, ...³³ I will scatter you among the nations and will draw out my sword and pursue you. Your land will be laid waste, and your cities will lie in ruins. ³⁴ Then the land will enjoy its sabbath years all the time that it lies desolate and you are in the country of your enemies; then the land will rest and enjoy its sabbaths.

- Do we know when this happened? One of two possibilities
- 1. Ezra 7:12-26 and the command to rebuild the temple in 457 B.C. 483 years later = 27 AD.
- 2. Nehemiah 2:5-8 and the command to rebuild Jerusalem, its temple, its walls, and houses in 444 B.C.



Nehemiah 2:1-8 In the month of Nisan in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes, ... ⁵ and I answered the king, "If it pleases the king and if your servant has found favor in his sight, let him send me to the city in Judah where my ancestors are buried so that I can rebuild it." . . . 6 It pleased the king to send me; so I set a time...⁸ the king granted my requests.


