Key Scriptures

Jeremiah 31:31-37 ³¹

"Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah-- ³² "not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. ³³ "But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. ³⁴ "No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more." ³⁵ Thus says the LORD, Who gives the sun for a light by day, The ordinances of the moon and the stars for a light by night, Who disturbs the sea, And its waves roar (The LORD of hosts is His name): ³⁶ "If those ordinances depart From before Me, says the LORD, Then the seed of Israel shall also cease From being a nation before Me forever." ³⁷ Thus says the LORD: "If heaven above can be measured, And the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel For all that they have done, says the LORD.

Key Point: God is not finished with Israel, or with you.

TALK IT OVER

Start talking: Pick a conversation starter for your group.

- Why do you think the promised land (Israel) has been the most embattled land in the world?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What do you remember from the message on Sunday about the events of Ezekiel 38? (you can cheat if you need to) 😊
- Read Jeremiah 31:31-37

What is God going to do one day, and how will it be different from the covenant God made with Israel's forefathers?

Why will there be no need for evangelism in that day? (34)

What will be the basis of that covenant?

- In Ezekiel 37:1-14, Ezekiel has a vision where he preaches to a valley of dry bones and they come alive. What does this represent? (v. 11-14)
- According to Romans 11:25-27, what will ultimately happen to Israel?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Israel is approx. the size of NJ. Russia is 800x larger. It is a democratic republic surrounded by 22 hostile Arab/Islamic dictatorships that are 60x her population. Why do you think God would allow a future battle with such overwhelming odds against Israel as will happen in Ezekiel 38?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray that as you see the signs of prophecies nearing fulfillment that you would be able to clearly live out the will of God and do it in His power.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week!

- Read through Romans 11 and reflect on what God says about Israel and about you as well. What do you need to do in response to this?
