

## The End Part 14

### Key Scriptures

Rev. 19:11-21 <sup>11</sup> Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. <sup>12</sup> His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. <sup>13</sup> He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. <sup>14</sup> And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. <sup>15</sup> Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. <sup>16</sup> And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS . . .

<sup>19</sup> And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. <sup>20</sup> Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. <sup>21</sup> And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

## TALK IT OVER

**Start talking:** Pick a conversation starter for your group.

- When you heard the word “Armageddon” what normally came to your mind?

**Start thinking.** Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- From Revelation 16 describe the events that take place prior to, and at, Armageddon:  
What do the seven bowls in verse 1 represent?

What did the first angel pour out on those worshipping the Antichrist (v.2)?

What happened to the oceans as a result of the 2<sup>nd</sup> bowl (v. 3)?

What is the reason for the 3<sup>rd</sup> bowl (v. 4-6)?

What is the content of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> bowl judgments? (v.8-10)?

What did the 6<sup>th</sup> angel’s bowl accomplish (v. 12-16)?

What happens when the 7<sup>th</sup> angel pours out his bowl (v. 17-21)? How is v. 17 similar with John 19:30?

**Start sharing.** Choose a question to create openness.

- Imagine seeing the Second Coming with the angelic hosts and glorified believers with Christ. How do you think the armies at the battle and other people on earth will respond when they see this incredible spectacle? Explain.
- Kyle ended his sermon with 2 Cor. 5:20, “Therefore we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making His plea through us. We plead with you on Christ's behalf, “Be reconciled to God!” Does knowing the judgment of God in Armageddon change the urgency of that passage for you? Why or why not?

**Start praying.** Be bold and pray with power.

- Pray that as you see the signs of prophecies nearing fulfillment that you would be able to clearly live out the will of God and do it in His power.

**Start doing.** Commit to a step and live it out this week!

- Who are you currently acting as an ambassador for Christ with? What do you need to do as a faithful ambassador with them this week?
