Jesus' Epic Strategy: Discipleship

Our mission: To lead people into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ; by creating environments that encourage and equip people to pursue intimacy with God, community with insiders and influence with outsiders.

Key Scriptures

John 17:4 I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do.

Acts 2:42-47 ⁴² And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. ⁴³ Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. 44 Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, ⁴⁶ So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Key Point: One way to live right side up in an upside-down world is to go back to the original mission Jesus gave us.

Start talking: Pick a conversation starter for your group.

 What kinds of things did He do with them to finish the work The Father gave Him?
- If you were to restate Matt 28:18-20 in your own words, what is Jesus' epic strategy? Does it sound more to you like a command or like an enablement? Why?
- In Acts 1-4, Kyle drew five examples of what the early church was like.
 - o Acts 1:8 They were empowered by the Holy Spirit.
 - Acts 2:42-47 Close Authentic Community: with an emphasis of meeting house to house and eating meals together.
 - o Acts 4:24 They trusted God's Sovereignty and prayed together.
 - Acts 4:32-34 They were generous, sharing what they had with one another.
 - Acts 6 They mobilized every member in ministry and mission.

Is what the early church did consistent with how Jesus taught His disciples? How so?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

 In Acts 1-4, and how the church went from a small group of 120 disciples to thousands, and over time the church changed the culture. Do you believe culture could be transformed again? Why or why not?

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week!

 What is the next spiritual step you need to take? Baptism? Giving an offering back to God? Singing and Praising? Involving yourself in a ministry of the church? Serving someone? Reaching out to a person who is far from God?
