## Relationship Rehab: Roles

## **Key Scriptures**

Eph. 5:22-33 <sup>22</sup> Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.

<sup>24</sup> Now as the church submits to Christ. so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.<sup>25</sup> Husbands, love vour wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, <sup>26</sup> that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word. <sup>27</sup> so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. <sup>28</sup> In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.<sup>29</sup> For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are members of his body. <sup>31</sup> "Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." <sup>32</sup> This mystery is profound, and I am saying that it refers to Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> However, let each one of you love his wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

**Key Point:** Headship and submission are God's design for marriage in Christ.

## TALK IT OVER

**Start talking**: Pick a conversation starter for your group.

 Where are some of your favorite places you've visited in the U.S. and in the world?

Start thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- What is the theme of Ephesians 5:22-33?
- What are the specific things wives are called to do? What are the specific things husbands are called to do?
- How does what Paul wrote in Eph 5:17-21 lead into this section on our roles as husbands and wives?
- Bonus Question: What do you think verse 32 saying?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- In what ways are submission and headship difficult to obey? In what ways does this passage challenge you personally?
- Concerning v. 33, Kyle shared a summary of what biblical headship and submission looks like:

"Two words summarize verse 33; respect and protect. When wives submit to their husbands, what that looks like from a husband's perspective in real life is respect and honor, . . . and what it feels like is love. When husbands love their wives like Christ loved the church, what it feels like from a wife's experience is they are protected."

Do you feel like this is true from your own experience?

## Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week!

• If you are married, have a conversation about what headship and submission looks like (or should look like) in your marriage and decide to live out these roles.
